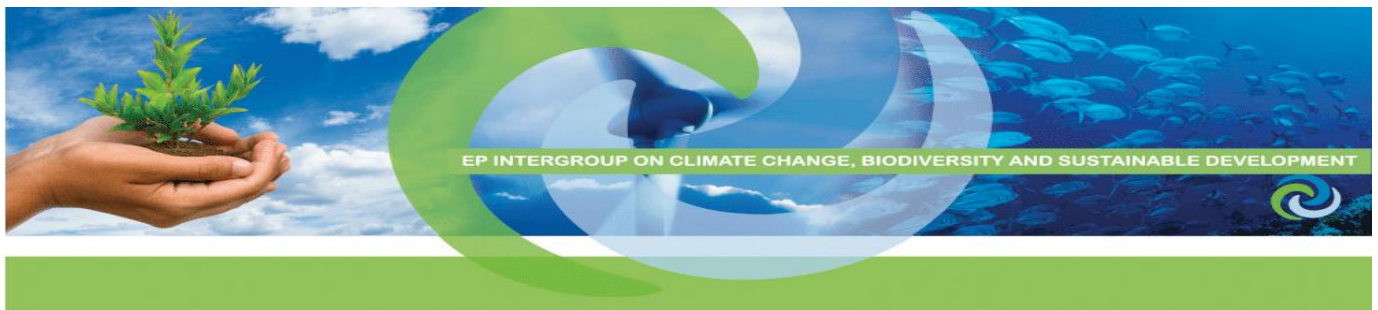
What are the best ways to address environmental considerations of the CFP? To which extent can regionalisation offer a solution? These are some of the questions that will be discussed during the meeting.
