The growing global problem of marine litter has been recognized by the United Nations Environmental Assembly, the International Whaling Commission, the Convention on Biological Diversity, and the Convention on Migratory Species. Identified by these multi-lateral fora and the European Commission as a priority for action, the issue of marine litter has very serious consequences and should be properly addressed.

This event will focus on the increasingly serious environmental, economic and health threats posed by marine debris and programs put in place by the European Commission to combat it. Scientists will characterize the problem, including its dimension and consequences. The European Association for Aquatic Mammals, which brings together zoological parks engaged in the public display, research and conservation of aquatic mammals, will discuss specific impacts on whales, dolphins and other marine life through ingestion and entanglement and introduce the international "Our World Oceans Month" social media campaign (#DebrisFreeSea) it launched on 1 June together with the Alliance of Marine Mammal Parks and Aquariums to raise awareness and motivate the public to take be part of the solution. Waste Free Oceans, a ground breaking public-private Foundation, will outline its work to mobilize and unite the fisheries sector, public authorities and the international plastics industry in combating floating litter on the coastlines, at the rivers and in the seas.
