  - A new boost for Jobs, Growth and Investment
  - A resilient Energy Union with a forward looking climate change policy
  - EU as an active global actor

#### EU R&I:

- Open Innovation, Open Science, Open to the World
- **Horizon 2020**, EU Research and Innovation Framework Programme, 2014-2020
- Focus on solutions, notably nature-based solutions to societal challenges such as climate change



#### 2016:

 Demonstrating innovative naturebased solutions for climate and water resilience in cities (Innovation action)

#### **Call: Greening the economy**

#### 2016:

Insurance value of ecosystems (R&I)

#### 2017:

Hydro-meteorological risk reduction (Innovation action)





# Innovation actions - Demonstration projects - implementation modalities

- Large scale multi-stakeholder demonstration projects
- 'Front-runner' (at least 2) and 'follower' (at least 3) cities/areas from EU MS and/or AC
- 'Front-runner' cities/ areas as living labs that
  - invest in, deploy, test, demonstrate nature-based solutions (NBS)
  - mentor, assist and advise 'follower' cities/areas
  - contribute to EU-wide evidence repository on NBS
- 'Follower' cities/areas commit to develop, within the duration of the project, a plan for re-naturing their city/area, integrating demonstrated nature-based solutions adapted to their context
