Within BiodivERsA3 (ERA-NET)

- Devoted Workpackage: «Integrating research programmes and addressing issues with and within Overseas territories/Outermost Regions» (Coordination: Région Guadeloupe)

Within BiodivERsA3 (ERA-NET)



- Participation in the current BiodivERsA3 co-funded call
- A second call dedicated to (sub)tropical biodiversity of Overseas regions, countries and territories?
 - Use of research priorities identified in NetBiome (ERA-Net, CSA) and BiodivERsA3
 - All partners from NetBiome invited to join in the financing and beyond (third countries, SME?)
