General experiences

- *No massive problems encountered to date*

However...

...unclear regulations & uncertainties are not a fisherman's friend



Unclear regulations

- *Point 11 of the Omnibus?*
- *How to deal with bycatch of 0 TAC species?*
- *How to discard e.g. forbidden species with closed discard chutes?*
=> Violation of labour conditions
- *What to do with meshed fish?*

Uncertainties

- *Sudden hake bycatch in western waters*
- *ABP provisions and undersized fish*
- *Minimum size mackerel 30 cm in the North Sea and 20 cm in Western Waters*
- *Bycatch of RSW vessels can only be detected in processing factories*

Solutions? Under construction!

- *Innovation and technical measures:*
 - *New pelagic grid in Sweden*
 - *Pelacoustics project in the Netherlands*
 - *SMAC project in Scotland*
 - *Closed areas and season in boarfish mp*
 - *etc...*

The way forward

- *Legal clarity & level playing field:*
 - *Resolve ambiguity*
 - *Provide easy to understand guides in all relevant languages, including Norwegian and Faroese*
 - *Equal treatment*



The way forward

- *Stakeholders consultation:*
 - *Slow progress in MS regional groups*
 - *But some very valuable ideas, e.g. gramme sizes*
 - *Closer cooperation in the future*
 - *Better compliance*
 - *Invite ACs to inter-regional workshops between EFCA and MS*

Take home message

The ACs are a cornucopia of knowledge and experience. Member States could and should make much better use of this resource.
