




# Ecosystem services for sustainable land use planning and natural resource management

- Ensuring

  - ecosystem services as a key player when building pathways for sustainable development locally, nationally, in Europe and globally

#### Research needs for resilience and tranformation

- means to deal with difficult trade-offs
- nature-based solutions in handling climate change, urbanisation, land use, human migration, production of goods
- integrated policy, practices and behavioural change for transformation
- justice and other ethical issues
