BACKGROUND

Aichi Biodiversity Target 6, adopted by the Conference of the Parties (COP) to the Convention on Biological Diversity, focuses on achieving sustainable fisheries by 2020. This has established both explicit and implicit requirements for fisheries in contributing to preservation of global biodiversity. The CBD Secretariat, FAO, the IUCN Fisheries Expert Group and other partners have enhanced their collaboration with a view to improving our understanding of the contributions of fisheries management to the achievement of the Aichi Targets, supporting the efforts of Parties in reporting on their progress towards Aichi Biodiversity Target 6, and in accelerating the mainstreaming of biodiversity conservation into fisheries management. This side event will shed light on the approaches taken by intergovernmental organizations and Parties to address these issues as well as the latest developments, challenges and successes in the sustainable use of aquatic biodiversity since the adoption of Target 6 in 2010.
