


Our Mission

Legislative coherence and preventive action





Recommendations



~ Apply TFEU 191.2

- Coherence between chemical legislation, environmental policies and Green Deal strategies (circular economy, zero pollution etc.).
- Precautionary principle, preventive action, control-atsource and polluter pays principle.

~ Focus on generic risk assessment

- Hazard-based approach essential to protect water resources.
- Restrict PMT substances / PFAS <u>before</u> they enter the environment.

\sim Favour family/group approach

 "One substance – one hazard assessment" . must not contradict group restrictions (PFAS, micro-plastics).

Recommendations



~ Ban all non-essential PFAS applications

- Limit values introduced in Drinking Water Directive.
- Define "essential" according to Montreal Protocol.

~ Apply the polluter pays principle

- If water operators must invest in complementary extratreatment (last resort).
- Address EDCs and Mixtures and Cocktail Effects in the Strategy
- ~ Support innovation
 - Sustainable green chemistry.
